## First Year Student Orientation and Registration Programme for Fall Semester 2017

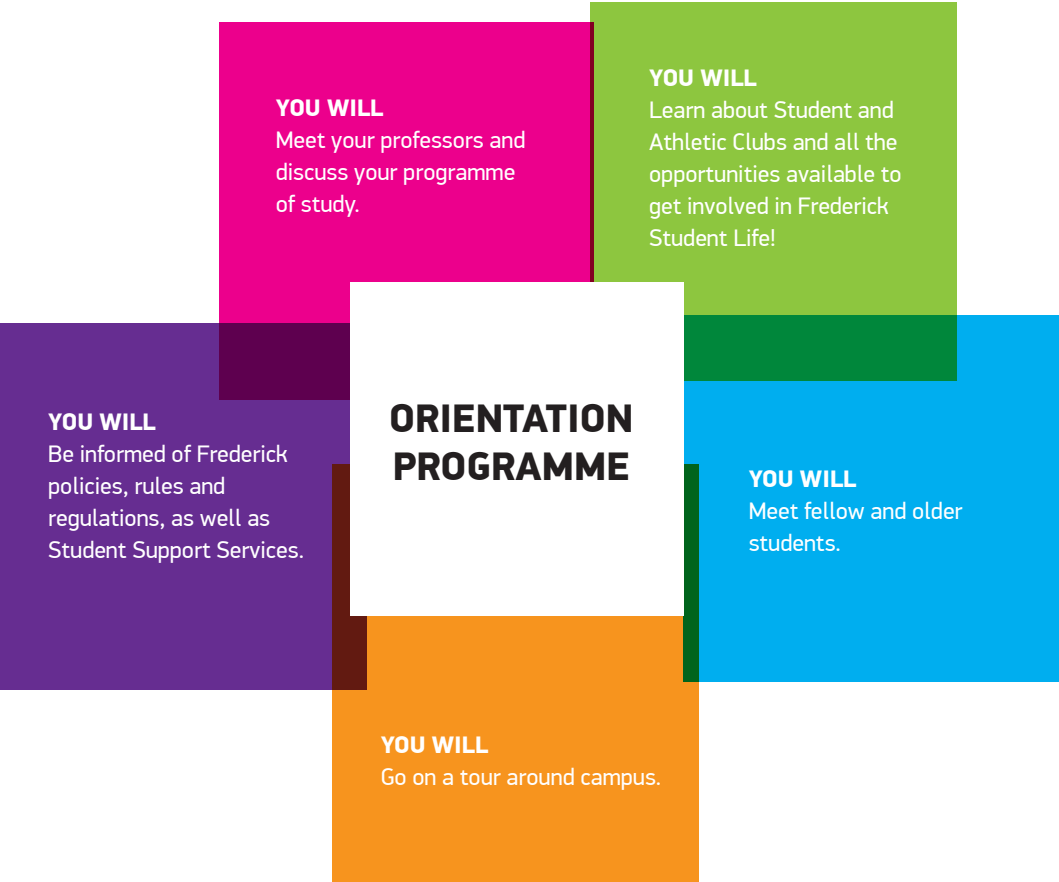
