Disciplinary misconduct and inappropriate behaviour during the exams

Students that have inappropriate behaviour or commit any disciplinary misconduct during the exams will be reported to the Disciplinary Committee.

Disciplinary offences are:

- Cheating or attempting to cheat at the exams
- The use of any unauthorised material
- The use of mobile phones during the exams*

*** The use of mobile phones, or other electronic communication or storage devices (including iPods, MP3/4 players, etc)** is not permitted and mobile phones must be switched off during the exams and placed in personal bags or pockets. If a student does not have a personal bag or pocket, the mobile phone should be placed in a place indentified by the invigilators. Students found with mobile phones or other electronic communication or storage devices (including iPods, MP3/4 players, etc) will be referred to the Disciplinary Committee.

Some of the **penalties** of the Disciplinary Committee in the cases of cheating or attempting to cheat are failing the course or even be expelled from Frederick Institute of Technology.
